Jo Lodge is a master at simple, interactive novelty books, with great child appeal. She is best known for her *Mr Croc* character which has sold over a million copies worldwide.





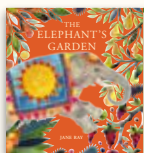

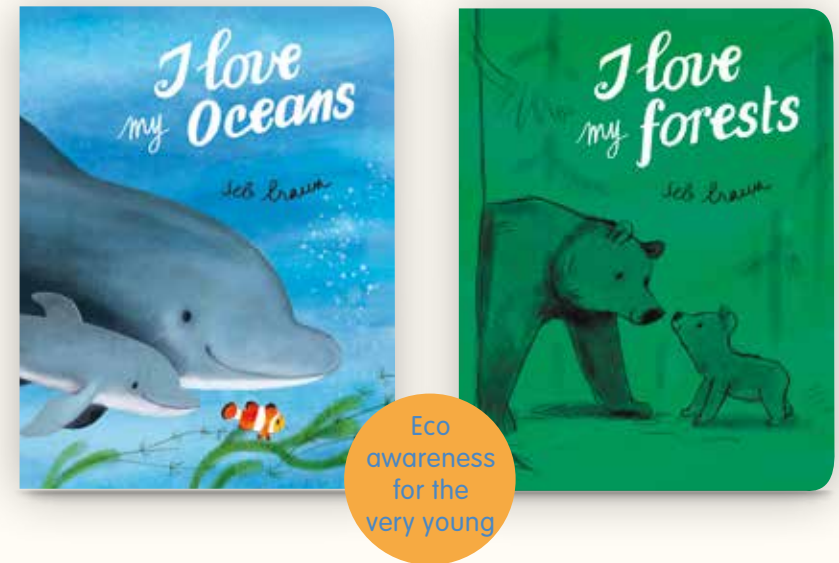


The Little Red Bus
